Jeremy Basch lives in Columbus, OH but is originally from Westlake, Cleveland, OH. He started keeping fish around 22 years ago when his father took him to a pet shop. At around 16 Jeremy started working at one of the local fish stores and started to acquire various sized aquariums and fish. He became hooked.

This continued until 2004 when he setup his first fishroom. Currently Jeremy is on his third modified fishroom design which now contains 100+ aquariums ranging in size from 2.5 to 150 gallons. Over the years, he has bred many species of fish including: cichlids, catfish, rainbows, killifish, livebearers and invertebrates. He was also the first person in the world to have the Jaguar Catfish, *Liosomadoras oncinus*, spawn and give viable offspring!

Jeremy's main focus is on the cichlids and catfish from South America and killifish from West Africa. He is a current member and the chairman of the Columbus Area Fish Enthusiasts. Other fish associations he has been involved with include: the Ohio Cichlid Association, the Greater Cincinnati Aquarium Society, the American Killifish Association and the American Cichlid Association. He has written various articles which have appeared in the Buntbarsche Bulletin, his hometown club, the CAFE Menu and Amazonas. His Amazonas article depicted his first successful breeding of *Liosomadoras oncinus*, the Jaguar Catfish. Jeremy can be seen at many fish shows and conventions throughout the Midwest and some of the National Shows.
